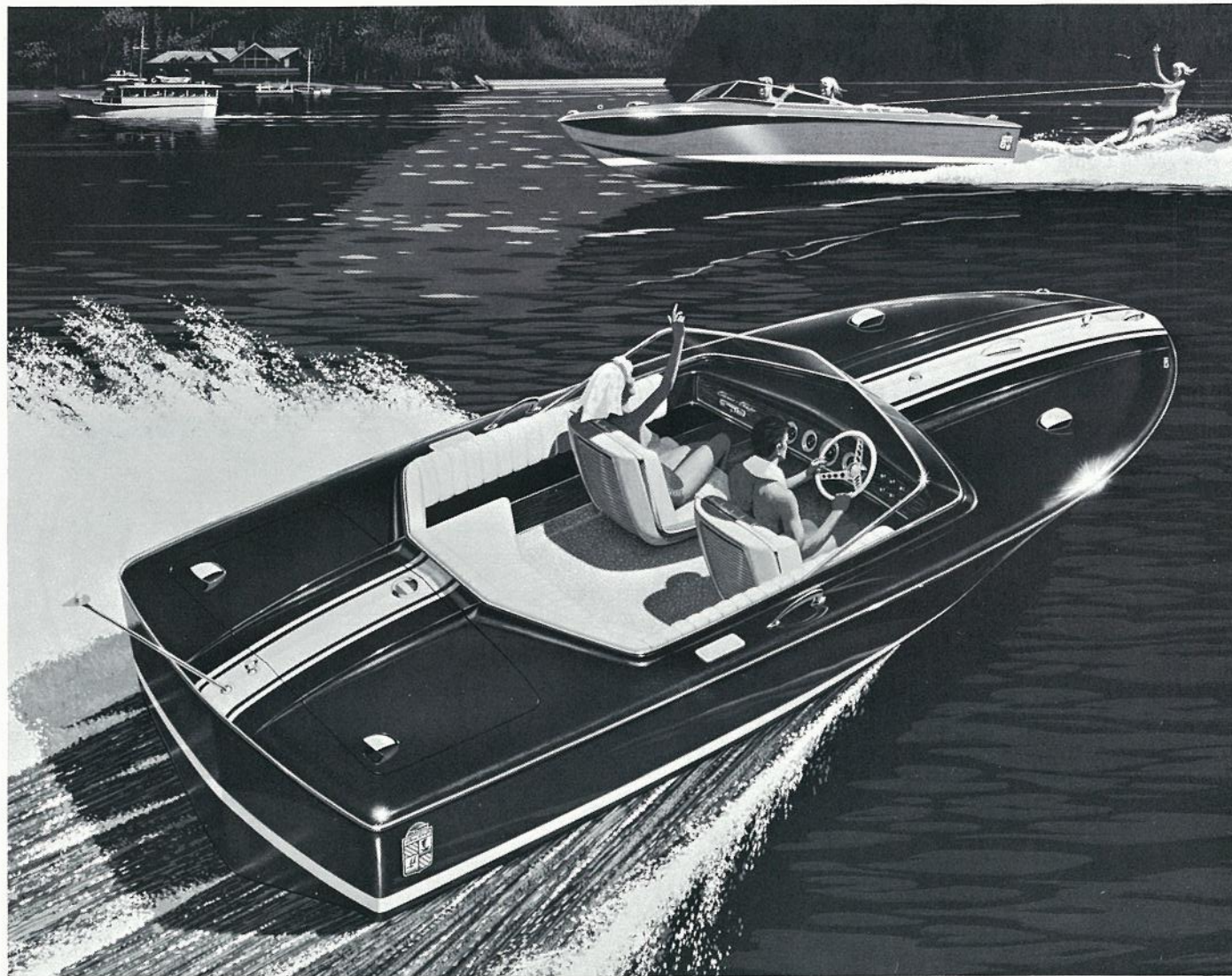


Chris★Craft® 1969 19' Commander Super Sport

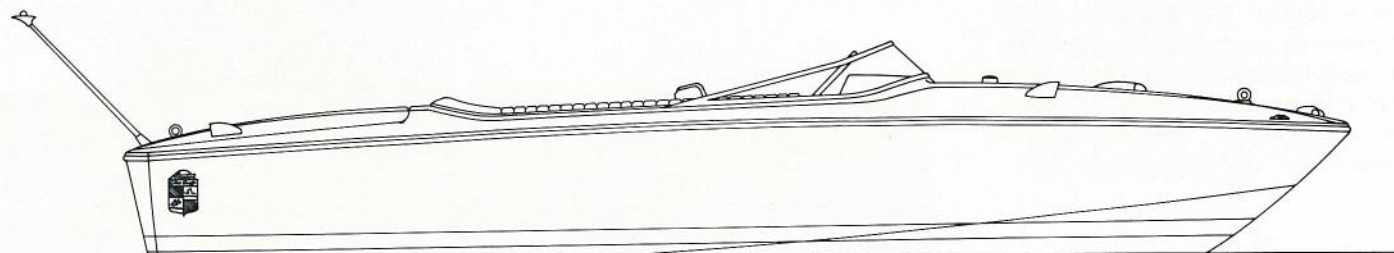

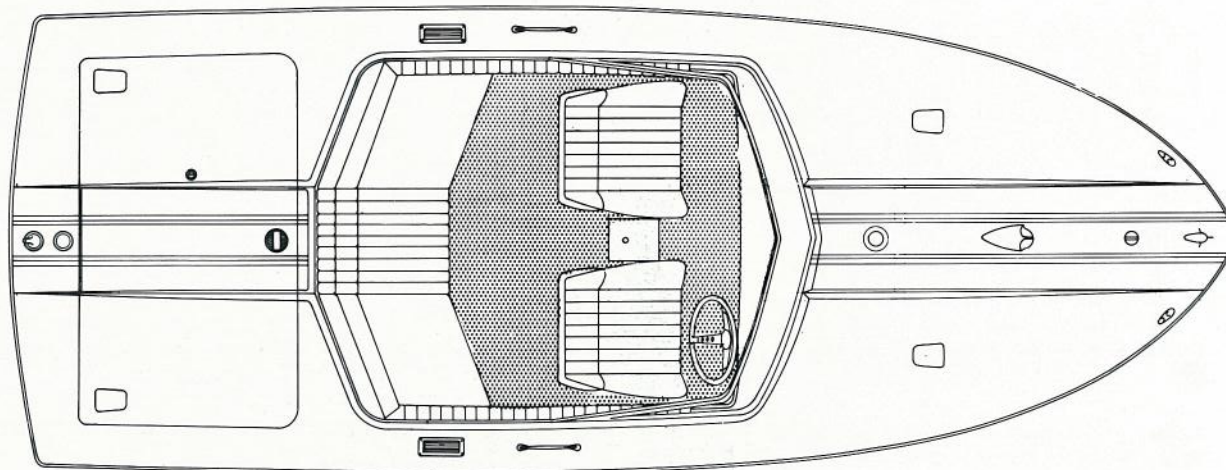
